In the 13th C some Christians began a hospital in London, England calling it St Mary of Bethlehem. It was a great benefit to the community. But as the years passed so did the staff & ownership of the hospital. Eventually it was converted into a hospital for the criminally insane. Back then those in asylums were chained, tied up or put in straight jackets & often abused. The facility became known for the shrieks & wailings of patients as their forlorn howls echoed thru the corridors of this once great hospital of healing. It's reputation turned to one of chaos & mayhem as cries of the damned reverberated from the dorms of the demented. Gradually its original name Bethlehem was shortened to Bedlam a word the English language coined describing wild uproar & noisy commotion.

No sooner did the shepherds hail the birth of Jesus & wise men give gifts, than **bedlam** broke out in Bethlehem. Angel said 'Get out of town, Herod's insane jealousy will bring horror & death to the city'.

And yet the story of Jesus birth that Xmas day which seemed to go so bad is turned to good. In spite of the evil of man, God is still good. Hope reigns in spite of the horror. It's the story and the glory of Christ birth.

Not much different today. Season filled w/ chaos—Past couple years many have been holding on tight to make it thru. We've dealt w/ mortgage crises & record job losses, market crashes and financial bailouts. Stimulus packages and Cas. We've struggled w/ covid-19, so called global warming and health care reform, Justice Dept CIA, FBI under scrutiny for illegal activity.

And on top of it all Xmas which is supposed to be a season of peace & joy but instead brings undue stress & chaos. And yet if we refocus & realize *God is the same yesterday, today and forever*, tonight He can bring blessings out of what seems like bedlam. Within the Xmas story is the glory of God & gift to you.

You may not get what you want for Xmas...in the material sense but God has an abundance of spiritual blessing that will not only carry you thru the

season but last throughout the year & into eternity. That is the Xmas story and the glory it brings.

Kids indulge, parents endure—malls, highway, spending, parking. If monthly, spoiled kids, parents die of exhaustion or nervous breakdown.

We miss real reason—for most <u>habit</u> or <u>expected</u> but cost, time, energy, moods—many would skip except for kids sake we keep on.

Simplicity & meaning gone, lost in commercialism (used to chop own tree now \$100; handmade gifts/malls; buy one per family member/dozens) Heart missing.

If get in time machine-back 2000 yrs-scene totally different. Centered one person, baby in manger—God directed--not drinking parties, commercialism and greed.

The story and the glory of Xmas

Jesus Himself was meek and gentle 'when reviled did not revile in return but kept entrusting Himself to the one who judges righteously.
