

David is king over all 12 tribes of Israel. David builds a palace 5:10-12 *And David became greater and greater, for the LORD God of hosts was with him. 11 Then Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David with cedar trees and carpenters and stonemasons; and they built a house for David. 12 And David realized that the LORD had established him as king over Israel, and that He had exalted his kingdom for the sake of His people Israel.*

Wood structure spoke luxury & stone common building material. Hiram supplied material & skilled workmen. George our developer Mike manager w/ various skilled sub-contractors built out CC facility.

1 Now it came about when the king lived in his house, and the LORD had given him rest on every side from all his enemies, 2 that the king said to Nathan the prophet, "See now, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of God dwells within tent curtains." 3 And Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that is in your mind, for the LORD is with you." 4 But it came about in the same night that the word of the LORD came to Nathan, saying, 5 "Go and say to My servant David, 'Thus says the LORD, "Are you the one who should build Me a house to dwell in? 6 "For I have not dwelt in a house since the day I brought up the sons of Israel from Egypt, even to this day; but I have been moving about in a tent, even in a tabernacle Ex26. 7 "Wherever I have gone with all the sons of Israel, did I speak a word with one of the tribes of Israel, which I commanded to shepherd My people Israel, saying, 'Why have you not built Me a house of cedar?'"

Nathan spoke to soon didn't confer w/ Lord...but God works in spite of us

My servant David 2x's 5,8 *My people Israel* 4x's 7,8,10,11. *They servant* 8x's 20,21,25,27,28,29 *They servant David* 26

God doesn't need fancy buildings to do His spiritual work in a persons life. In fact they can be a distracton, an idol as the temple became to Israel. Swear by the temple to make a binding oath. Or gold of the temple.

8 "Now therefore, thus you shall say to My servant David, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, that you should be ruler over My people Israel. 9 "And I have been with you wherever you have gone and have cut off all your enemies from before you; and I will make you a great name, like the names of the great men who are on the earth. 10 "I will also appoint a place for My people Israel and will plant them, that they may live in their own place and not be disturbed again, nor will the wicked afflict them any more as formerly, 11 even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel; and I will give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also declares to you that the LORD will make a house for you.

Reminder of David's calling *2Tim 1:6 I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.* Reminds him of God's faithfulness in dealing w/ enemies & plan for future *make you a great name.*

Dual prophecy Solomon temporary and Jesus eternal

What God did in past & what He'll do in future for David & people. The good shepherd is first concern for sheep, their protection & dwelling in security. God to build David a house, heritage, dynasty....David wanted build God a house...God to do one better--build David everlasting house, more enduring & glorious thru Messiah....

David a man of war, bloodshed. *1Chron 22:8-10 "But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, 'You have shed much blood, and have waged great wars; you shall not build a house to My name, because you have shed so much blood on the earth before Me. 9 'Behold, a son shall be born to you, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies on every side; for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quiet to Israel in his days. 10 'He shall build a house for My name, and he shall be My son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel forever.'*

12 "When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your descendant after you, who will come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom. 13 "He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. 14 "I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I will correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men, 15 but My lovingkindness shall not depart from him, as I took it away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. 16 "And your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever." 17 In accordance with all these words and all this vision, so Nathan spoke to David.

Throne forever... Messiah Jesus....David's family *descendants seed* sons after David reigned 408 yrs then cut off *Jer 22:30 Jehoiachin-Coniah 2Ki24:9 Matt Joseph royal line Lk Eli/mary blood line Is 11:1,2 Then a shoot will spring from the stem of Jesse, And a branch from his roots will bear fruit. 2 And the Spirit of the LORD will rest on Him, The spirit of wisdom and understanding, The spirit of counsel and strength, The spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.*

Isaiah 9:6,7 Jesus *Heb 1:5 Thou art My son today I have begotten Thee* both Solomon & Jesus...chastise *1Ki 11:11 So the LORD said to Solomon, "Because you have done this, and you have not kept My covenant and My statutes, which I have commanded you, I will surely tear the kingdom from you, and will give it to your servant. 1Pet 2:24 and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.*

18 Then David the king went in and sat before the LORD, and he said, "Who am I, O Lord GOD, and what is my house, that Thou hast brought me this far? 19 "And yet this was insignificant in Thine eyes, O Lord GOD, for Thou hast spoken also of the house of Thy servant concerning the distant future. And this is the custom of man, O Lord GOD. 20 "And again what more can David say to Thee? For Thou knowest Thy servant, O Lord GOD! 21 "For the sake of Thy word, and according to Thine own heart, Thou hast done all this greatness to let Thy servant know. 22 "For this reason Thou art great, O Lord GOD; for there is none like Thee, and there is no God besides Thee, according to all that we have heard with our ears. 23 "And what one nation on the earth is like Thy people Israel, whom God went to redeem for Himself as a people and to make a name for Himself, and to do a great thing for Thee and awesome things for Thy land, before Thy people whom Thou hast redeemed for Thyself from Egypt, from nations and their gods? 24 "For Thou hast established for Thyself Thy people Israel as Thine own people forever, and Thou, O LORD, hast become their God.

Gods goodness should create gratitude and humility, not 'I deserve it' 'it's about time'Also exhaltation of God...Servant repeated...How we take 'no' for an answer reveals much about us...do we have the same zeal, commitment, love for Lord or do we go into hiding, self pity....David's faith brought him into atmosphere where God dwells....all promises to happen in future after David gone..

Adonai-Jehovah Lord our sovereign 6x's 22,9,20,28,29

One Nation :23-Israel not two....and *forever* :24 no 10 lost tribes

British Israel theory 1880's— British & American people are 10 lost tribes—Britain is Ephraim America Manasseh—all the promises of Israel belong to Britain & America not to Jews—Royal family of England true legal heirs of Davidic throne—Coronation stone/destiny of England is original Jacob pillow Gen 28

25 “Now therefore, O LORD God, the word that Thou hast spoken concerning Thy servant and his house, confirm it forever, and do as Thou hast spoken, 26 that Thy name may be magnified forever, by saying, ‘The LORD of hosts is God over Israel’; and may the house of Thy servant David be established before Thee. 27 “For Thou, O LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, hast made a revelation to Thy servant, saying, ‘I will build you a house’; therefore Thy servant has found courage to pray this prayer to Thee. 28 “And now, O Lord GOD, Thou art God, and Thy words are truth, and Thou hast promised this good thing to Thy servant. 29 “Now therefore, may it please Thee to bless the house of Thy servant, that it may continue forever before Thee. For Thou, O Lord GOD, hast spoken; and with Thy blessing may the house of Thy servant be blessed forever.”

David prays the promises of God...that when they come to pass God gets glory....God loves us to use His *certificate of currency* in heaven...cash it out ...receive His promises—*found \$10 certificate fishing reel*...if not use it, lose it—promises of God goes unclaimed *Eph 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 2Pet 1:4 For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, in order that by them you might become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.*

26 *forever magnified—David’s house established- Is 53:8 By oppression and judgment He was taken away; And as for His generation, who considered That He was cut off out of the land of the living, For the transgression of my people to whom the stroke was due? :14 iniquity corrected...innocent Pilate ‘I find no guilt in this man’ Judas ‘I have betrayed innocent blood’ Thief ‘this man has done nothing wrong’ Centurion ‘worshiped...surely this righteous man’*

Ch 8:1 Now after this it came about that David defeated the Philistines and subdued them; and David took control of the chief city from the hand of the Philistines. 2 And he defeated Moab, and measured them with the line, making them lie down on the ground; and he measured two lines to put to death and one full line to keep alive. And the Moabites became servants to David, bringing tribute.

Philistines enemies of Israel lived coastal area of Mediterranean in South & constant threat to Israel. Moab product incest of Lot & older daughter Gen 19:36. One line/cord **height**—young spared two lines/cords adults to death.

3 Then David defeated Hadadezer, the son of Rehob king of Zobah, as he went to restore his rule at the River. 4 And David captured from him 1,700 horsemen and 20,000 foot soldiers; and David hamstringed the chariot horses, but reserved enough of them for 100 chariots. 5 And when the Arameans of Damascus came to help Hadadezer, king of Zobah, David killed 22,000 Arameans. 6 Then David put garrisons among the Arameans of Damascus, and the Arameans became servants to David, bringing tribute. And the LORD helped David wherever he went. 7 And David took the shields of gold which were carried by the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem. 8 And from Bethah and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, King David took a very large amount of bronze.

Hadadezer--Northern enemies—1Sam 30 S enemies already defeated. Hadadezer a Canannite *“storm god is my help”* ruled Aramean/Syrian kingdom of Zobah.

Hamstrung *‘cutting back sinews of hind legs which disabled from military activity’* Not mutilation. Damascus strategic city – located at crossroads of two main international hwy. – Via-Maris going S & W to Egypt and Kings hwy leading E of Jordan river and S to Arabia.

Shields-trophies or decorative war memorials or insignias not use in battle but for decoration—commemorating victory

9 Now when Toi king of Hamath heard that David had defeated all the army of Hadadezer, 10 Toi sent Joram his son to King David to greet him and bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer and defeated him; for Hadadezer had been at war with Toi. And Joram brought with him articles of silver, of gold and of bronze. 11 King David also dedicated these to the LORD, with the silver and gold that he had dedicated from all the nations which he had subdued: 12 from Aram and Moab and the sons of Ammon and the Philistines and Amalek, and from the spoil of Hadadezer, son of Rehob, king of Zobah.

Hamath a Syrian territory 100 mi N of Damascus – King Toi sends gifts to David by his son as sign of peace & friendship & submission as a vassal – silver and gold stored and later used in building temple 1Ki 17:51

13 So David made a name for himself when he returned from killing 18,000 Arameans in the Valley of Salt. 14 And he put garrisons in Edom. In all Edom he put garrisons, and all the Edomites became servants to David. And the LORD helped David wherever he went. 15 So David reigned over all Israel; and David administered justice and righteousness for all his people. 16 And Joab the son of Zeruiah was over the army, and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud was recorder. 17 And Zadok the son of Ahitub and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar were priests, and Seraiah was secretary. 18 And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and David's sons were chief ministers.

Fulfills 7:9 reputation *great name* Ruled from Gulf of Aqaba & River of Egypt to Euphrates river—what God promised Abraham **Gen 15:18** *On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying "To your descendants I have given this land, From the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates:*

David's reign of justice & righteousness **Ps 89:14** *Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Thy throne; lovingkindness and truth go before Thee'*

Joab nephew, son of David's sister 1Chr 2:13-16 until Solomon put him to death. Jehoshaphat recorded state affairs, advised and brought state concerns to David--an official in Solomons reign.

Zadok and Ahimelech faithful priests, spiritual leaders during David's reign. Seraiah Davids' secretary, Benaiah 'the Lord builds' commander of David's personal bodyguard...later commander in Solomons reign who puts to death Joab.

Can't help but think of Trump putting together his cabinet and getting rid of woke & corrupt people in current administration.
