We are not of night nor of darkness; <sup>6</sup>so then let us not sleep as others do, but let us be alert and sober. <sup>7</sup>For those who sleep do their sleeping at night, and those who get drunk get drunk at night. <sup>8</sup>But since we are of *the day*, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet, the hope of salvation. <sup>9</sup>For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>10</sup>who died for us, that whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with Him. <sup>11</sup>Therefore encourage one another, and build up one another, just as you also are doing.; **1Cor 15:51** <sup>51</sup>Behold, I tell you a mystery; we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, <sup>52</sup>in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. ;

City of Tyre Ez 26:1-16 prophesied between 592-570 BC

Seven predictions w/in these verses.

**1.** Nebu shall take the city of Tyre (6-11) **2.** Other nations are to participate in the fulfillment of the prophecy (3-5) **3.** The city is to be made flat like the top of a rock, walls destroyed, break down towers

(4,15) 4. It is to be a place for the spreading of nets (5,14) 5. Its stones and timbers are to be laid in the sea (12) 6. Other cities are to fear greatly at the fall of Tyre (16) 7. The old city of Tyre shall never be rebuilt (14).

So it has been estimated thru principles of probability that the chances Ezekiel could have accurately predicted these seven events of city of Tyre is one in 75 million according to Science Speaks by Peter Stoner & verified by ASA-American Scientific Affiliation.
